



## *Do It Again* *Day 4: Bridge*

### *Scripture Reference*

Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

- *Matthew 17: 20-21*



We enter this verse in a time when Jesus is answering an extremely important question in response to His disciples. The disciples had attempted to heal a boy of demons, but the disciples were unable to drive them out. The disciples ask of Jesus, "Why couldn't we drive it out?" (Matthew 17:19). Jesus responds, "Because you have so little faith."

*Do you ever find yourself asking God why you don't have the strength or abilities to overcome a particular challenge in front of you? Maybe today He is answering "Because you have so little faith." Do you doubt God will give you the strength to overcome the walls (or mountains) we talked of earlier in the week? Ask God to help you in your unbelief; ask Him to give you faith. He can, and He will.*

Jesus tells us that if we have faith as small as a mustard seed, we can instruct the mountain to move, and it will. A mustard seed is commonly 1 to 2 millimeters in size, a speck at best. However, the plant produced can grow to be upwards of 9 feet tall. Jesus is saying to the disciples, and to us, that our little faith can be transformed. It can grow.

*Does knowing your faith can grow bring you any peace today? One tiny act of faith today can grow into much greater faith in the future. How can you take steps to ensure your "little faith" today is only a temporary label? How can you work with the Holy Spirit to grow your faith?*

Through faith as small as a mustard seed, we can move mountains. Nothing will be impossible, Jesus says. There are no exclusions or exceptions in that statement. As our song says, Jesus can make a way. Through Him, we can move mountains and make paths forward. Take comfort in this thought: the disciples had overcome demons in the past, and they would do so again in the future.

*What area in your life do you need help from God to make a way forward? What expectations are you bringing to your relationship with Jesus for His fulfillment of that path forward? Take a moment to identify a time in the past when Jesus made a way for you that maybe didn't quite line up with how you would have expected the way forward to look like.*

We are meant to move mountains with the help of Jesus. He will make a way for us. However, we must also remember, that when we pray and act in faith, we are hoping for the will of God to be achieved. That will may not always look like our will.

*Could God's form of "moving the mountains" in front of you be different than what you imagine? Pray today that God would continue to grow your faith and that you should move the mountains to achieve His perfect will. Thank God that His perfect will is even better than our own expectations.*
