Rhythms of Faith

Daily Devotionals Based on Songs

Immediately before our passage, in Deuteronomy 31:4, Moses reminds the people of God's provision in conquering Sihon and Og, the kings of the Amorites. In this, Moses takes the opportunity to remind the people of Israel that God has never failed them yet. He can and will deliver them again. Even in a time when the people of Israel had a great leader like Moses, they required reminders of God's faithfulness and deliverance.

How does the above context remind you of the song we've been studying over the past week? Do you need reminders of God's faithfulness and deliverance? Has the week been challenging to recall past challenges God has overcome? Are you in a time where despair is easier to cling to than hope? Speak that to God and pray that He would lead you into a place, or maybe even an earthly relationship, that can serve to remind you of His faithfulness in your life.

In Deuteronomy 31, Moses is handing leadership over to Joshua. It comes shortly before our Day 1 passage of Joshua 6 and the conquering of Jericho. In today's passage, Moses tells the people of Israel "do not be afraid or terrified because of them." He is referring to the many enemies facing his people, many with strong walls and fortifications, just like Jericho. At this time, though, the people did not have the foresight to know they would conquer Jericho. They only knew of their enemies; not of God's specific instructions and plans for conquering Jericho.

How would you respond today if you knew God would fully conquer your challenge tomorrow? Begin responding that way now...because God has already overcome the challenge you are facing. Even though you may not know what the future holds, God does. Challenge yourself and ask the Holy Spirit to help you to act as if you've already overcome the walls you've expressed this week.



As our passage states, the Lord your God goes with you. Our song puts in in the context that you are still in His hands. God does not leave us - even when we may feel completely alone. God is faithful and He's with you in all of life.

God goes with you. Take a moment to let the gravity of that statement fully sink in. Maybe you know it, but are you really living like it? Are you making choices, taking actions, loving others as if God is with you - even in the midst of your challenges?

Our song ends in the repetitive reminder: You've never failed me yet, I never will forget. Through many scriptures this week, we've studied God's faithfulness to His people, His protection, His provision, and His deliverance. You - yes you - you are included in His people. Oh, what a beautiful thing is God's love for us. Let us never forget.

End this week in a prayer of worship and thanksgiving. Take a moment to look over your reflections from today and each day of the week. Pour out your praise for God's faithfulness. Pour out your praise for His provision in your past walls, His strength in your current mountains, and His unfailing love for you throughout all of life. And never forget.
