*Scripture Reference*

Teach me to do your will,  
for you are my God;  
may your good Spirit  
lead me on level ground.

– *Psalm 143:10*



When we first studied this chorus on Day 3, we focused on the anticipation that a believer feels with the Holy Spirit. Today, that anticipation turns towards actual change. Change the Holy Spirit brings in the hearts of believers. Yesterday, we alluded to this transformation. A transformation that only He can create and bring to completion. However, that transformation can only occur if we are willing to let the Holy Spirit do His work within us.

*Start today praying in the strength of the Holy Spirit. Ask your Heavenly Father to bring transformation through the Holy Spirit into your life. Speak words of excitement and anticipation. If you aren't feeling excitement or anticipation, release that over to your Heavenly Father. Welcome the Holy Spirit.*

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Your heart longs for the Glory of God. We were designed for that as we discussed previously. When the Holy Spirit enters your heart, He begins to work a transformation. Part of that transformation is a desire to do His will. It's the age-old question – is it faith or deeds? Take a moment to read James 2:14-26. Through our faith, we are given the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit works in us to bring desire for God's will and glory into fruition. With a desire for His perfect will, we take action. We are changed through the Holy Spirit.

*Do you gravitate towards the concept of faith or the concept of deeds? How do you personally reconcile the difference? Does this concept still bring some confusion to your relationship with God and your daily living? Can you recognize any differences in your actions or motivations prior to becoming a believer? If so, take some time to reflect on those with your Heavenly Father.*

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“Lead me on level ground.” This concept of level ground points towards uprightness, justice, straightness. Being led in God’s perfect will. Because His will is truly perfect. We may not always fully understand it. We may not even get what we asked, or begged, for. But His will is working for your good. The Holy Spirit within us helps us better understand and appreciate that perfect will. Through the Holy Spirit, we can surrender the desires of the flesh (our sinful desires) and instead seek uprightness – even if this brings struggles.

*Are there any specific situations in your life where pursuing God’s will still allowed struggles or pain in your life? How do you recognize that God’s will was still perfect? Are there still areas in your life that you aren’t quite sure how the Holy Spirit was working for your good? Ask the Holy Spirit to shed light in understanding that area or experience.*

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As a believer, you welcome the Holy Spirit into your life. You are a temple for the Holy Spirit. He lives in you. With that comes anticipation, hope, and transformation. Transformation of mind, heart, desires, and will. You now seek the glory of God. You have direct communication and relationship with Him. You are never alone. When you soak in the inherent depth of these truths, you can be overcome by the presence of the Lord.

*End this week meditating on these truths. What do you feel the Holy Spirit has been teaching you this week? In what areas do you feel you need to gain more insight or wisdom? End today praying to your Heavenly Father. Have a few minutes of true reflection and authenticity with your Lord. Feel the presence of the Holy Spirit in this place filling the atmosphere. Be overcome.*

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
